will be the keynote speakers, along with the **Bishops of Washington State.**

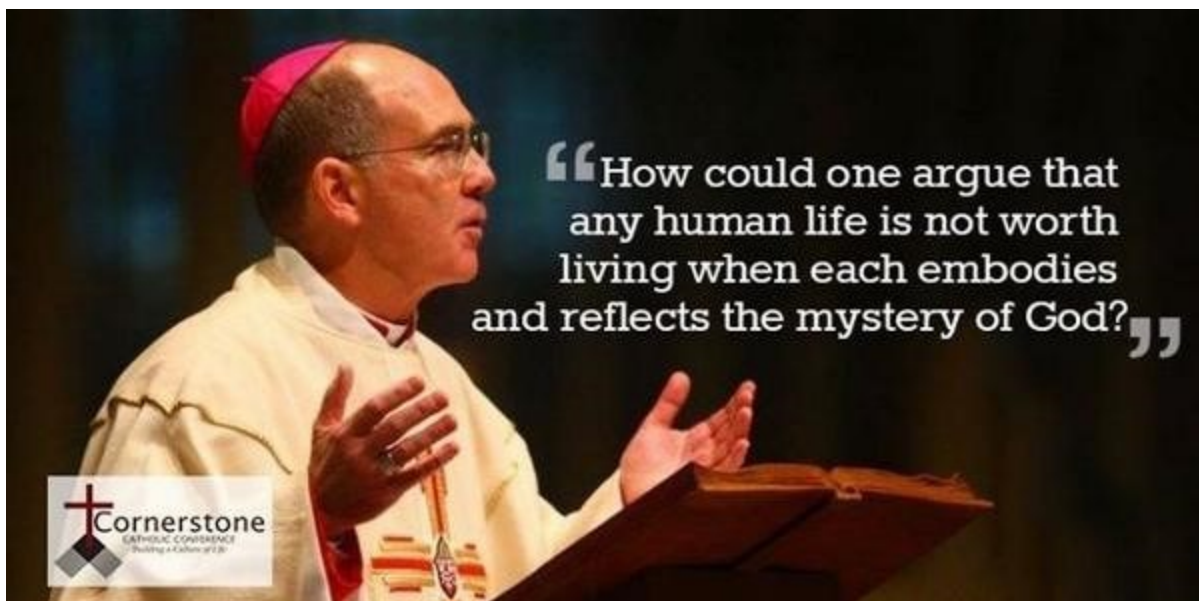
The Nov. 15th meetings will provide you with information about how the 2017 Cornerstone Catholic Conference is shaping up and how you can help bring it to fruition.
